

## **SCH SAFETY CONCERNS**

**Dear Parents/Guardians:**

**As we begin the 2018/2019 school year, the School City of Hammond would like to stress to you and our student that their safety and well-being are one of our top priorities. Please discuss with the following issues with your students:**

**Listed below are reminders for our parents and guardians that drop children off and/or pick children up:**

- **Students should be dropped off no sooner than the time indicated by the building principal for adult supervision. This is determined in the best interest of student safety and supervision.**
- **Please be aware of children that are in the parking areas that are entering school.**
- **Always be aware of children jaywalking or crossing streets from any angle to get to school. Be reminded that jaywalking is not allowed by the Hammond Police Department.**
- **Please do not drop your children off on the street and require them to walk between other vehicles to get to the school.**
- **For those students attending Hammond High School, new construction will begin soon please bear with us any inconvenience.**

**Our administration advises our students to:**

- **Use sidewalks/walkways/crossing guards while walking to and from school.**
- **Cross streets at appropriate intersections.**
- **Please walk in groups until you arrive home or reach your destination.**
- **To obey traffic signals.**
- **Observe railroad crossings without climbing over or going under a stopped or slow moving train at any time. If late due to a confirmed train situation, children will be excused.**
