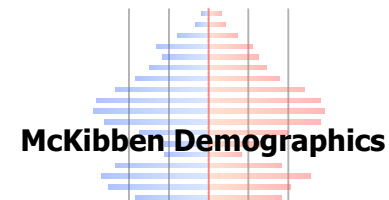

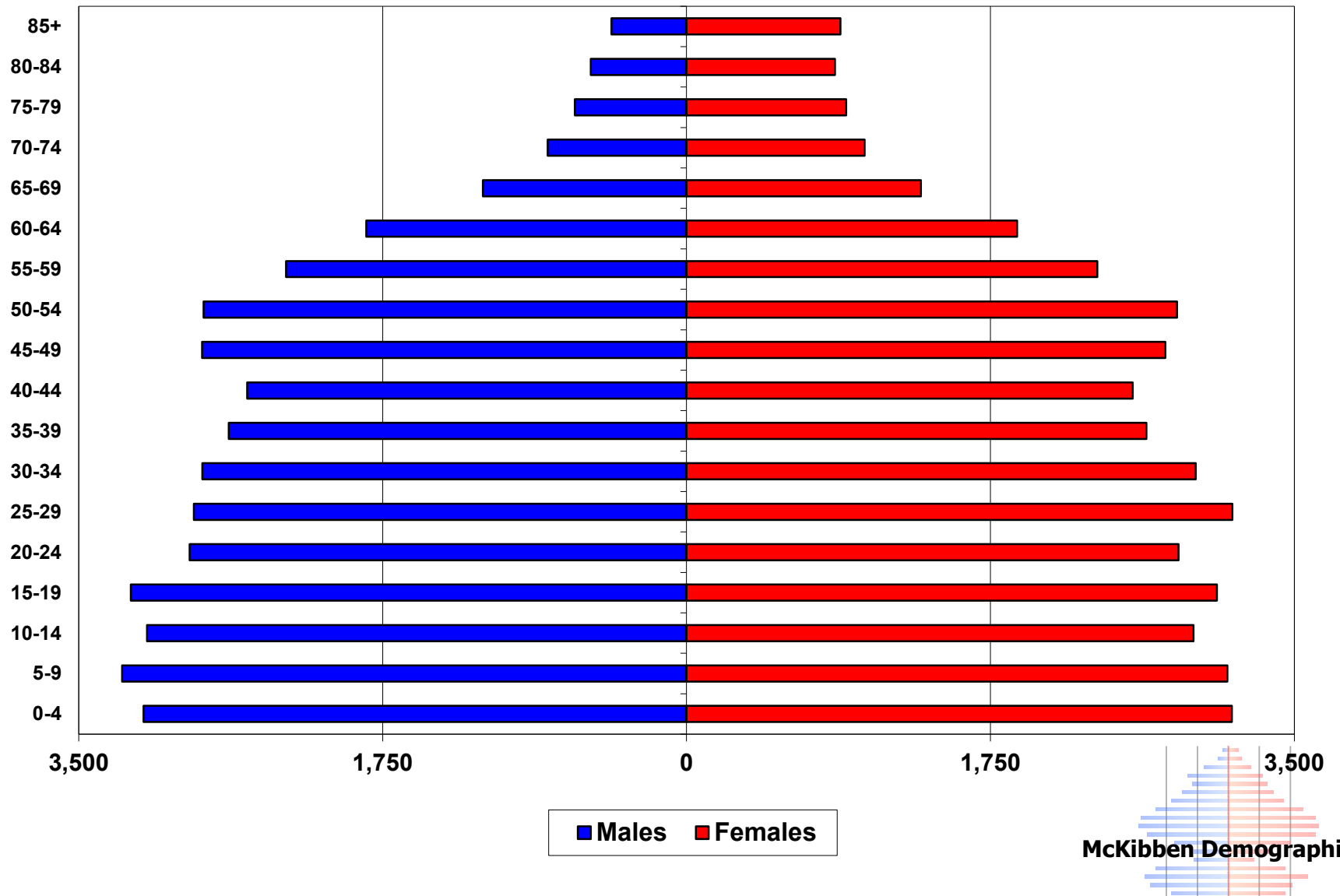
# School City of Hammond Forecast Assumptions

1. The national, state or regional economy does not go into deep recession at anytime during the 10 years of the forecasts; (Deep recession is defined as four consecutive quarters where the GDP contracts greater than 1% per quarter)
2. Interest rates have come off their historic lows and will not fluctuate more than one percentage point in the short term; the interest rate for a 30 year fixed home mortgage stays below 5.0%;
3. The rate of mortgage approval stays at current levels and lenders do not return to “sub-prime” mortgage practices;
4. There are no additional restrictions placed on home mortgage lenders or additional bankruptcies of major credit providers;
5. The rate of housing foreclosures does not exceed 125% of the 2005--2008 average of Lake County for any year in the forecasts;
6. All currently planned, platted, and approved housing construction is built out and completed by 2027. All housing units constructed are occupied by 2028;
7. The unemployment rates for the Lake County and the Gary Metropolitan Area will remain below 7.0% for the 10 years of the forecasts;
8. The intra district student transfer policy for the district remains unchanged over the next 10 years;

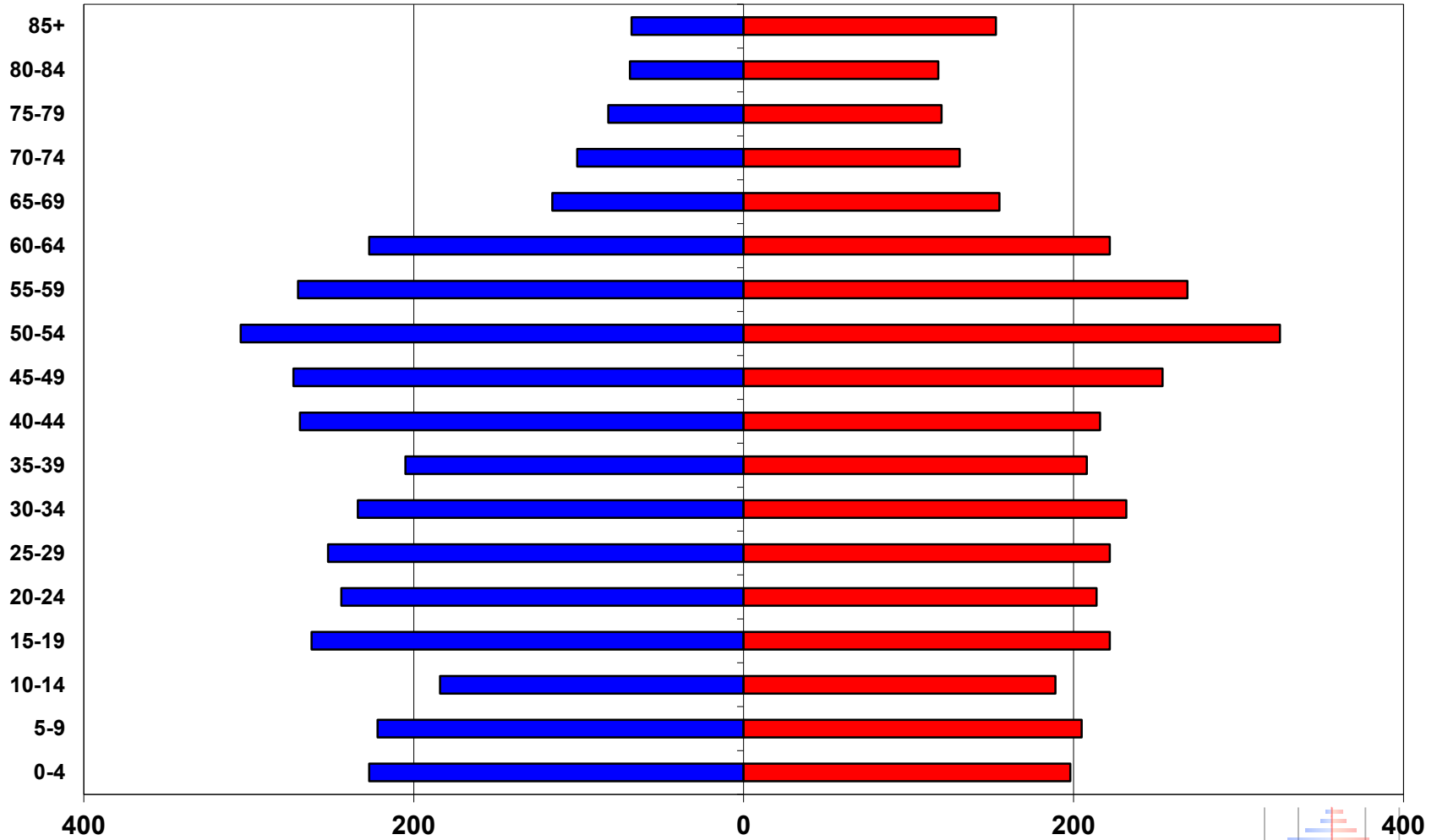
# School City of Hammond Forecast Assumptions, continued

9. The State of Indiana does not change any of its current laws or policies regarding charter schools, vouchers or inter-district transfers;
10. No additional charter schools open in Lake County over the next 10 years;
11. The rate of students transferring into and out of the School City of Hammond will remain at the 2014-15 to 2018-19 average;
12. The School City of Hammond does not change it's inter-district transfer policy over the next 10 years;
13. The inflation rate for gasoline will stay below 5% per year for the 10 years of the forecasts;
14. There will be no building moratorium within the district;
15. Businesses within the Gary Metropolitan Area and the School City of Hammond will remain viable;
16. The number of existing home sales in the district that are a result of "distress sales" (homes worth less than the current mortgage value) will not exceed 20% of total homes sales in the district for any given year;
17. Housing turnover rates (sale of existing homes in the district) will remain at their current levels. The majority of existing home sales are made by home owners over the age of 60;
18. Private school and home school attendance rates will remain constant;
19. The rate of foreclosures for commercial property remains at the 2004-2008 average for Lake County.

# School City of Hammond - Total Population 2010 Census

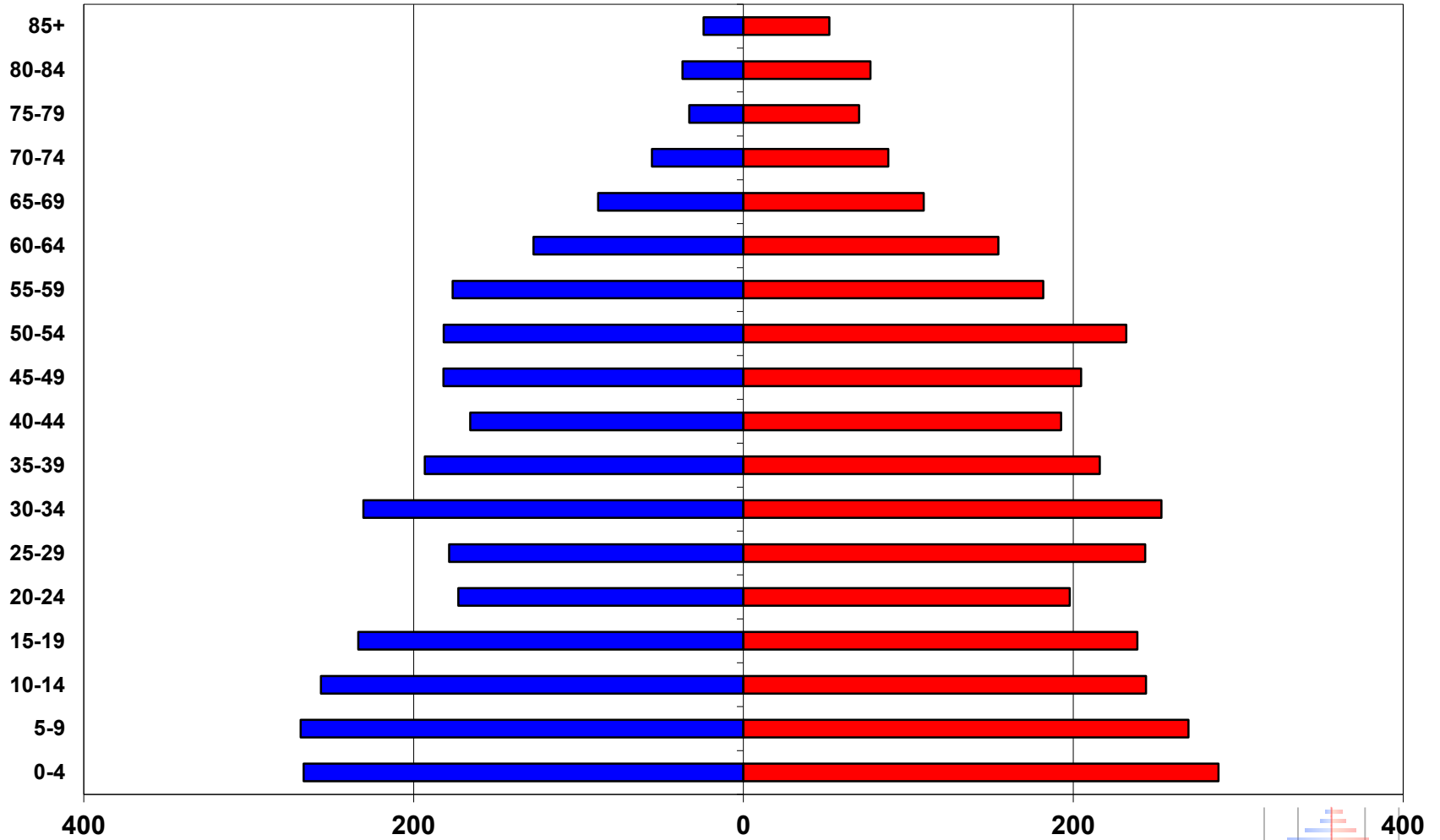


# Franklin Elementary 2010 Census

# O'Bannon Elementary 2010 Census



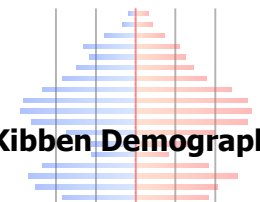
