

Immunization Requirements for the 2010-2011 School Year

Changes to the school immunization requirements for school year 2010-2011 are as follows:

- a. All preschool and kindergarten students will be required to have 2 doses of varicella vaccine, given on or after the first birthday and separated by 3 months, or a history of chickenpox disease.**
- b. All kindergarten students will be required to have one of the required doses of polio vaccine given on or after the fourth birthday, and at least 6 months after the previous dose.**
- c. All 6th-12th students will be required to have 2 doses of varicella vaccine, given on or after the first birthday, and separated by age-appropriate intervals as defined by the CDC, or a history of chickenpox disease.**
- d. All 6th-12th graded students will be required to have 1 dose of tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap) given on or after the 10th birthday.**
- e. All 6th-12th grade students will be required to have 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (Meningitis/MCV4)**
